COMMITMENT

The time commitment for Oxnard Leadership includes 10 full-day sessions, plus a two-hour Welcome Reception and Graduation. Participants are expected to attend all 10 sessions and be present for 75 percent of the day. Sessions will be held from approximately 8:00am – 4:00pm every third Friday, January-October.

Participants may miss no more than two sessions in order to graduate. Please discuss this application with your employer/supervisor to ensure that you will have sufficient time to participate in the program and fulfill the necessary requirements.
